

What really is Consecration and what are the benefits? It is bringing Christ into the center of our family life. While we live out this "promise" in every aspect of our life, the Holy Family and the Holy Trinity molds us, uses us and protects us...until we all see each other in heaven, our ultimate home.



Living in Unity in a love that is lasting. We promise to walk as one with each member of the family. We were reminded to put God first as we build our identity as a family, creating traditions and celebrations that lasts lifetimes.



Growing in Virtue. While it is not easy, it brings us so much joy when everyone makes an effort to motivate each other to be a better person. PREPARING FOR OUR DAY OF CONSECRATION

Here are some suggestions for preparing our families for Consecration Day

1. CONFESSION

It is always a good idea to be in a state of grace before a Consecration. It puts our hearts in a disposition of purity before God and the Holy Family. If can be arranged, set an appointment with your parish priest for your family to go to Confession (with masks of course). Otherwise, do an **Act of Perfect Contrition** (<u>http://catholicfirst.com/thefaith/prayers/perfectactcontrition.html</u>), with the promise to go to Confession as soon as it is possible.

2. EXTRA MASS

If you could attend Mass, either online or face to face, this would also be ideal. Especially since it's the season of Simbang Gabi's, it will be wonderful to avail of the sacraments as often as we can.

3. SAY AN EXTRA PRAYER FOR EACH ONE

Circle of Prayer for the week - assign one to pray for a specific member of the family everyday.

4. GO THROUGH THE CONSECRATION PRAYER AS A FAMILY

We have been using parts of the Consecration Prayer throughout these past 7 weeks. Take time to read through the whole prayer again , clarifying some prayers, if necessary. 5. PREPARE YOUR CONSECRATION ALTAR

Dress up the special place you have used these entire 9 weeks as your family altar and have this beside you on Consecration Day.
